When faced with such situations, divorce experts and attorneys always encourage the aggrieved homemakers to fight for their rights by creating foolproof divorce settlement agreement that caters to their interest in terms of financial as well as emotional losses; and here is a small list of core matters that can be mentioned in this respect.

- Financial support /compensation that can help the aggrieved party maintain the same lifestyle.
- Child custody and support. This applies mostly when children are very young / pre adults and are dependent upon their mother for basic case
- Property rights for self and children. Here, the aggrieved party needs to comprehensively identify marital assets be it property, funds, jewellery, luxury vehicles / items etc and claim her share of the same. Property settlement agreements can be drawn separately with the assistance of legal professionals.
- Health care and medical support. Here, if the aggrieved homemaker suffers from some medical conditions (curable or incurable), the initiator of the divorce will have to offer support for treatments, medication, medical procedures and anything else that may be required.
- Right to reside under the same roof till divorce is finalized. This applies if the concerned homemaker is unable to find a decent place to move into or has to stay back for the sake of children. Here, the other party cannot force his spouse to leave the premises under specified or unspecified grounds.

Creating a divorce settlement agreement that is mutually agreed upon can get tough. Therefore, seeking assistance from professionals is highly recommended in such cases.
